Men's County Am

Saturday, Aug. 5, at The Golf Club at Cedar Creek, Onalaska (par 71)
Sunday, Aug. 6, at Drugan's Castle Mound, Holmen (par 72)
ENTRY DEADLINE: Midnight July 24

The 36-hole stroke play tournament will feature five flights – Championship, First, Second, Third and Fourth. Adult players wishing to declare Championship Flight may do so regardless of handicap.

All players must be male, amateur golfers and meet at least one of the following:

1. Resident of La Crosse County.
2. Employed in La Crosse County.
3. Players with active memberships at golf courses within La Crosse County.

Players enrolled in high school must:

1. Be a resident of La Crosse County.
2. Have a maximum USGA slope of 5.8 by July 24, 2017.

All golfers must have a United States Golf Association handicap card, which is current as of July 24, 2017.

Golfers with a USGA slope index of 5.8 or less must play in the Championship Flight. The remaining golfers will be divided into four flights – First, Second, Third and Fourth.

Player entry fee is \$105, which covers greens fee, power cart fee and prize fee.

All players will be paired by the rules and pairings committee. New pairings will be made for the second day of the tournament. Tee times will begin at 7 a.m. both days for Second, Third and Fourth flight players. Tee times will begin after noon both days for First and Championship Flight players.



Women's County Am

Saturday, July 29, at The Golf Club at Cedar Creek (par 71)
ENTRY DEADLINE: Midnight July 17

The Women's 18-hole stroke play tournament will feature a minimum of three flights – Championship, First and Second. Women's players wishing to declare Championship Flight may do so regardless of handicap.

All players must be female, amateur golfers and meet at least one of the following:

1. Resident of La Crosse County.
2. Employed in La Crosse County.
3. Players with active memberships at golf courses within La Crosse County.

All golfers must have a United States Golf Association handicap card, which is current as of July 17, 2017.

Golfers with a USGA slope index of 11.0 or less must play in the Championship Flight. The remaining golfers will be divided into two flights – First and Second.

Player entry fee is \$60, which covers greens fee, power cart fee and prize fee.

All players will be paired by the rules and pairings committee.

Saturday, July 29, at Forest Hills Golf Course (par 71)
ENTRY DEADLINE: Midnight July 17

The Seniors 18-hole stroke play tournament is for ages 50 and older as of July 29, 2017. Golfers will compete in a minimum of four flights – Championship, First, Second and Third based upon a full field. Seniors' players wishing to declare Championship Flight may do so regardless of handicap.

NEW THIS YEAR: Players aged 70 and older may declare and compete in a Low Net Score Super Seniors Division.

All players must be male, amateur golfers and meet at least one of the following:

1. Resident of La Crosse County.
2. Employed in La Crosse County.
3. Players with active memberships at golf courses within La Crosse County.

All golfers must have a United States Golf Association handicap card, which is current as of July 17, 2017.

Golfers with a USGA slope index of 8.0 or less must play in the Championship Flight. The remaining golfers will be divided into three flights – First, Second and Third.

Player entry fee is \$60, which covers greens fee, power cart fee and prize fee.

All players will be paired by the rules and pairings committee.

IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT REMINDERS:

- The Men's, Seniors and Women's County Am are spikeless tournaments. All players must wear non-metal spikes. Acceptable footwear includes flat-soled shoes, tennis shoes, non-metal or non-ceramic spikes or spikeless golf shoes. Proper clothing is required.
- No entry fee will be refunded after the tournament deadline. Deadlines are midnight July 17 (seniors and women's) and midnight July 24 (men's).
- Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse or disqualify any player who does not meet tourney criteria.
- In the event of inclement weather, it is the player's responsibility to check with the host golf course about any schedule changes.
- The Golf Club at Cedar Creek, a private course, has set aside **Friday, July 28**, as the practice day for players entered in the County Amateur. Fee is \$42, including tax, for 18 holes of golf and cart, payable at the course on the day of practice round. Call the golf shop for tee times.
